**Home Repair
Loans Available**

The City of Warren's Residential Rehabilitation Program is accepting applications from income-eligible households for low or no-interest loans. The loans are used to bring the home up to code and make repairs to owner-occupied single-family residences. The maximum loan amount is \$30,000. To qualify for the program, applicants must **own and occupy** the home, have homeowner's insurance, have a history of making their house and property tax payments (including the water bill) on time, and have a household income that is below the limits established by The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). **Contact Community Development at 574-4686 or visit our website at www.cityofwarren.org to receive an expression of interest form.
