# No Street Parking During Snow Alerts

## \$165 Police Tickets

- Within six hours after the snow alert has taken effect, all motor vehicles and trailers must be removed from any city street.
- Upon the expiration of the six-hour period, any motor vehicle parked on any city street may be **towed** and/or ticketed by order of the Police Department.
- **Violation of any provision shall result in the assessment of fines of \$165 per violation, plus costs and other sanctions for each infraction. Vehicles which have a license plate or properly placed placard designating the vehicle for disabled parking are EXEMPT from the parking restriction. Those vehicles with disabled parking licenses plates or placards should be parked AS CLOSE TO THE CURB AS POSSIBLE.**
- Sidewalks **MUST** be cleared of snow and ice within 12 hours after snow has stopped. Where there is no sidewalk, the occupant or business owner shall clear a path free from snow and ice to facilitate pedestrian use. Tickets and fines may be imposed for not clearing sidewalks.
