

Home Repair Loans Available

The City of Warren's Residential Rehabilitation Program is accepting applications from income-eligible households for low or no-interest loans. The loans are used to bring the home up to code and make repairs to owner-occupied single-family residences. The maximum loan amount is \$30,000. To qualify for the program, applicants must **own and occupy** the home, have homeowner's insurance, have a history of making their house and property tax payments (including the water bill) on time, and have a household income that is below the limits established by The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). **Contact Community Development at 574-4686 or visit our website at www.cityofwarren.org to receive an expression of interest form. Up To \$500 Fine For Violating Warren's Fireworks Regulations

Seven Important Rules For A Safe 4th of July

- Fireworks cannot be discharged while under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs (zero tolerance).
- Minors under the age of 18 are prohibited from discharging fireworks with the exception of low impact fireworks (example: sparklers) under the supervision of a parent or guardian.
- Fireworks cannot be discharged on any street in Warren. Traffic cannot be impeded at any time.
- Discharge of fireworks prohibited in any public park, school property, city streets and sidewalks and easements, including the ITC corridor.
- Discharge of fireworks cannot disrupt the public peace and cannot cause debris on private and public property.
- Discharging fireworks prohibited within 30 ft. of any house, structure, building, vehicle or landscaping.
- After 11 p.m., Warren police will enforce violation of disturbing the peace.
