
Smoke Detector

The Fire Department will be distributing free smoke fire stations:  
**Station #2** – 23293 Schoenherr (north of 9 Mile), 9 a.m. – 4 pm;  
**Station #4** 6361 Chicago Road (west of Van Dyke) 9 a.m. – 4 p.m., and **Station #6** 3090 12 Mile (between Ryan and Dequindre) 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. one per household while supplies last.

The department issues the following safety tips: 1) Install smoke alarms on every level of your house. 2) Change smoke alarm batteries once a year or with seasonal time change. 3) Test smoke alarms once a month. 4) Make and practice a home fire escape plan. 5) Establish a meeting place in the front yard in the event of an emergency.
