

PUBLIC NOTICE  
HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH HIV/AIDS  
LAPEER, LIVINGSTON, MACOMB, OAKLAND AND ST. CLAIR COUNTIES

The City of Warren will receive \$540,800 in HOPWA (Housing Opportunities for Persons with HIV/AIDS) program funds available to serve the counties listed above. The City proposes funding the following activities to meet the highest priority housing needs identified for persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families: 1) emergency housing assistance \$60,000; 2) housing advocacy \$205,236; 3) tenant based rental assistance \$80,000; 4) in home nonmedical care for the medically fragile \$120,000; 5) administration \$15,564; 6) permanent housing placement \$60,000.
