What is foster care?

- In its simplest form, foster care is *temporary* care provided by a foster family to a child who has been removed from his or her home due to abuse or neglect.
- In reality, foster care provides a child with a place of safety, a sense of belonging, and a normal family life.

What can a foster parent do for a child?

- Love and accept the child without trying to replace the birth parent(s).
- Provide the things that all children need: food, clothing, a comfortable home, love, security, stability, and educational, recreational and social opportunities.

Who are the children in need of foster care?

- Infants, toddlers, school-age children, and teenagers. A single child, or sibling groups of brothers and sisters. Children of varying races and cultural backgrounds.

What is adoption

- Adoption is the legal process of making a child a permanent member of your family and legal heir.
- Adoption is established by law with all the rights and responsibilities that would exist with birth families.

Who are the children in need of adoption?

- Children currently in the foster care system awaiting permanent placement with their forever families. Many of these children have special needs because of their emotional scars and past suffering.
- There are often groups of brothers and sisters who need adoptive homes. Staff try to place these children together whenever possible.
