City of Warren and Macomb County Reach Agreement on Filling Potholes

Warren, MI – Warren Mayor Jim Fouts and Macomb County Executive Mark Hackel have reached an agreement for city DPW crews to fill potholes on county-maintained roads in the city.

Fouts contacted Hackel by phone Wednesday to collaborate with the county on the roads. Hackel agreed and all potholes on the roads will be filled by Warren DPW workers.

The city will be reimbursed by the county for time spent by city workers filling the potholes. All patching materials will be provided by the county to the city.

The potholes on county roads will be filled by the city after normal working hours after 3:30 p.m.

Unit pricing for double time is \$77.41 per man/per hour. It will be a flat fee of \$65.00 per hour for truck use, which includes insurance, gas and wear and tear.
