## **Warren Court-Ordered Clean-Up** **Tuesday, June 2 at 11 a.m.**

**Warren, MI** – As a direct result of Mayor Jim Fouts' clean sweep program, a court-ordered clean-up of property at 25495 Pineview will be implemented today at 11 a.m.

The property owner was given two weeks to clean up his property before blight tickets were issued by the city's property maintenance inspectors.

When Fouts was elected in 2007, he immediately initiated annual blight sweeps from April to October.

So far, over 150,000 properties have been inspected over the 7-year period. "The vast majority of property owners clean up their properties after receiving 5-day warning notices by inspectors," said Fouts. "In this case, the owner was given two weeks, so we got a district court order to remove the eyesore and charged the property owner for all expenses. This situation is intolerable."
