

The City of Warren Seeks Comments on 2016 Justice Assistance Grant

Based on local needs and conditions, the Warren Police Department, Macomb County Community Corrections, the Macomb County Sheriff's Office are applying for a United States Department of Justice JAG Grant that is designed to combat crime and enhance traffic and officer safety.

The money from the grant will go to aid several law enforcement projects including support for offenders with substance abuse issues through Macomb County Community Corrections' jail diversion program; the Sheriff's Office will replace outdated mobile computer equipment for squad cars and the Warren Police Department will use the funds to enhance traffic safety, purchase officer safety equipment and speed measuring devices.

The public is invited to review the Memorandum of Understanding and the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program — FY 2016, Local Solicitation application and to make comments. It will be available for inspection at the City of Warren City Clerk's Office located at One City Square, Warren, Michigan 48093 — during normal business hours, 9am to 4pm, June 13 through June 17, 2016.
