

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

This letter is a NOTICE HEREBY GIVEN to you that a public hearing has been scheduled and will be held by the City Council for the City of Warren in connection with the following petition to rezone land in your neighborhood:

A parcel of land in part of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, T1N, R.12E, City of Warren Macomb County, Michigan, Parcel Identification number 13-26-451-001 (no address Nine Mile) and 13-26-451-002 (23055 Groesbeck) more particularly described as:

Commencing at the southeast corner of said Section 26; thence along the east and west $\frac{1}{4}$ line of said Section 26 and centerline of Nine Mile Road, N89°53'00"W 1,522.92 ft.; thence N00°07'00"E 60.00 ft. to the intersection of the northerly R.O.W. line of Nine Mile Road with the westerly R.O.W. line of Groesbeck Highway and point of Beginning of this described parcel; thence proceeding along the northerly R.O.W. line of Nine Mile Road, N89°53'00"W 619.40 ft.; thence along the southeasterly R.O.W. line of G.T.W.R.R., N29°56'30"E 1,617.02 ft.; thence S00°49'00"E 1,046.32 ft.; thence along the westerly R.O.W. line of Groesbeck Highway (M-97), S29°37'35"W 409.83 ft. back to point of beginning containing 12.47 acres of land, more or less, subject to and together with any easements, restrictions or reservations affecting this described parcel.

be rezoned from its present zoning classification M-2, Medium Light Industrial District to zoning classification M-3, Medium Heavy Industrial District.

The public hearing will be held **Tuesday, May 12, 2015**, in the City Council Chambers of the Warren Community Center Auditorium, 5460 Arden, located west of Mound between Chicago and Fourteen Mile Roads.
