

## PLASTIC REFERENCE GUIDE



Plastic soft drink and water bottles, mouthwash and salad dressing bottles. Peanut butter, mayo, pickle, jelly and jam jars.



Paper or plastic milk and juice cartons, shampoo, dish and laundry detergent bottles, cereal liners, grocery, trash and retail bags.



Clear food and non-food packaging and electrical cable insulation.



Dry cleaning, bread and frozen food bags, squeezable bottles (honey, mustard, etc.)



Catsup bottles, yogurt containers, margarine tubs, medicine and vitamin bottles.



Compact disc jackets, food service applications, aspirin bottles, cups and plates. (No Styrofoam.)



Three and five gallon reusable water bottles, and some citrus juice bottles.

Please rinse/clean containers before putting into recycling bin.

**Styrofoam Containers and Packaging**  
Recycling Center Only



**Electronics**  
Recycling Center Only



**Kitchen Oils**  
Recycling Center Only



**Used Clothes**  
Recycling Center Only

#### CURBSIDE PICKUP ITEMS:



**Cardboard & Paper Bags**  
Flatten and cut into pieces  
No wax coated cardboard



**Paperboard, Milk & Juice Cartons**  
No wax coated paperboard



**Magazines & Catalogs**  
All types and sizes



**Junk Mail**  
Envelopes, flyers, brochures  
postcards



**Office Paper**  
All types and sizes



**Phone Books**  
All types and sizes



**Kitchen Cookware**  
Metal pots, pans, tins & utensils



**Steel & Tin Cans**  
Empty cans only



**Newspaper**  
Remove bags, strings and  
rubber bands



**Clear Glass**  
Empty, clear glass only



**Aluminum Cans**  
Empty cans only



**Plastic Jugs/Bottles**  
(#1 & #2)



**Household Plastic (#3 - #7)**  
Empty containers only



**Plastic Bags**  
Retail & grocery bags

#### RECYCLING BIN FULL?



Clear plastic bags can be used for additional items if your bin is full.
