

## **Final Water Bill and Final Water Bill Fee**

**What is a Final Water Bill** – Final reconciliation of any unpaid water and/or sewer utility fees that are the payment obligation of the current occupant, renter, and owner. A final read of the water meter is required for the date of occupant change to assure no carry over liability to the successor renter, owner, occupant up to the agreed upon closing or changeover date.

Water and sewer accounts are attached to the property address and not to an individual.

Without a Final Water Bill the successor occupant may find their responsible for any outstanding balance remaining on the account. Therefore, it is important to clear the account so the successor occupant or owner does not incur an outstanding balance from the prior occupant or owner.

**A new Final Water Bill Fee of \$15.00 was approved by Warren’s City Council on June 14, 2016. Effective August 1, 2016 the Final Water Bill Fee will be implemented on all request except for those accounts that are on Landlord Tenant Agreement Contracts with the City’s Water Division.**
