9-Year-Old Child Rescued after near Drowning at Pool – Child in critical condition at area hospital

The Warren Police Department would like to provide an update to a near drowning which occurred earlier this afternoon. The 9-year-old child involved in this incident is in critical but stable condition at an area hospital.

Today (06/17/2024) at approximately 05:55 pm, Warren Police and Fire Units were dispatched to the Kings Pointe Apartment Complex (14863 E. 12 Mile Rd) regarding a drowning involving a 9-year old. Officers quickly responded to the pool area and observed family members actively performing CPR on a 9-year old male child. The child had been rescued by adults on scene after remaining under water for several minutes. Officers immediately assessed the child and confirmed that he was breathing on his own. Officers stood by with the child and family until the Warren Fire Department arrived on scene and took over medical care. The Warren Fire Department treated and transported the child to an area hospital with Warren officers escorting the ambulance to the hospital. The child remains in critical but stable condition as of this date/time. Members of the Warren Police Detective Bureau responded to the scene to conduct a follow up to this incident which will include interviews with the child's parents and other family members.

This is an open and active investigation. Warren Police Commissioner Charles Rushton responded to the scene as well.
