2 Suspects Arrested for Assault in Warren Neighborhood – Victim listed in critical condition

The Warren Police Department would like to provide an update regarding an assault which took place this afternoon near a residence in the 22,000 block of Karam Court in the City of Warren. There is no threat to the community as both suspects in this incident were quickly arrested by the Warren Police Department. The victim in this incident was transported to an area hospital and is listed in critical condition with head trauma.

The preliminary details of this incident show that today (06/03/2024) at approximately 1:13pm, Warren Police and Fire Units were dispatched to an address in the 22,000 block of Karam Court regarding an assault in progress. Dispatch received several 911 calls advising that two suspects were assaulting a victim by delivering kicks and stomps to the victim while he was on the ground. Officers arrived on scene and located the 25-year-old male victim unconscious and laying the street. Officers immediately rendered first aid with the Warren Fire Department transporting the victim to an area hospital wherein he is currently listed in critical condition. Officers conducted an initial investigation and learned that two male suspects had likely entered a nearby residence after the assault. Officers made contact at this residence and placed one suspect, a 32-year-old male, under arrest without incident. Investigators arrived on scene to execute a search warrant at the suspect's residence to gather evidence. During the execution of the search warrant, the second suspect was taken into custody inside the residence without incident. This suspect is a 34-year-old male and brother to the first suspect.

Investigators learned that the victim and the 32-year-old suspect had an argument over money. A fight ensued between these two individuals. At some point in the fight, the victim fell onto the street. At this time, the 34-year-old suspect exited a residence and engaged in the assault on the victim while the victim was on the ground in a defenseless position. Several witnesses reported both suspects delivering "kicks and stomps" to the upper body and head area of the victim. No weapons were used in this incident. Investigators are confident that this incident was not random as all parties are known to each other.

This is still a very active investigation. Investigators are continuing to process the scene and gather evidence. Investigators plan to present the facts of the case on Wednesday (06/05/2024) to the Macomb County Prosecutor's Office for a review and charging decision.
