Warren Fire Department responds to Commercial Fire

The Warren Fire Department would like to provide an update regarding a Commercial Fire at a local business today. On 06/29/2024 at approximately 6:00 a.m. The Warren Fire Department was dispatched to Chicago Deli on 13 Mile Road for lite smoke coming from the building. Upon arrival fire crews were met by an employee waving at the front entrance of the building. Fire crews encountered heavy smoke conditions coming from the roof and front of the building.

Crews quickly and simultaneously set up roof operations, and breached the front door of the structure and begin extinguishment of the fire. After extinguishment, fire crews began to check for additional fire extension and after finding none deemed the fire out.

The Battalion Chief on scene stated that there were no injuries to civilians or Fire department personnel.

Fire crews were on the scene for approximately 2 hours, returning to service at 8:01 a.m. Fire investigators will be returning to the scene today to confirm the origin and cause of the fire, however preliminary reports suggest that the fire was accidental in nature and caused by faulty equipment.
