Warren Police Arrest 2nd Suspect from Fatal Crash – \$1 million bond issued

The Warren Police Department would like to provide an update regarding the arrest of the second suspect from last Saturday's vehicle pursuit which resulted in the death of 42-year-old Katrina Michael. Yesterday afternoon, members of the Warren Police Special Operations Unit took 26-year-old Damaree Terry of Pontiac into custody without incident at his workplace in Auburn Hills.

Warren Police Crash Investigators have been continuing to investigate the events and circumstances that resulted in the tragic death of Ms. Michael on 06/29/2024. After reviewing and examining numerous pieces of evidence and interviewing several witnesses, investigators were able to determine that Damaree Terry was in fact the driver of the second Dodge Charger which fled from officers on 06/29/2024. Recall that the second Dodge Charger did not stop after the Dodge Charger driven by 26-year-old James Hudson struck a Jeep occupied by Ms. Michael on 10 Mile near Dei Street. Investigators submitted the facts of the case regarding Terry to the Macomb County Prosecutor's Office for review. The Macomb County Prosecutor's Office reviewed the facts and issued the following charges against Terry:

- Homicide Murder 2nd Degree (life felony)
- Fleeing & Eluding 1st Degree (15-year felony)
- 3 counts of Fleeing & Eluding 2nd Degree (10-year felony) each count
- o 3 counts Reckless Driving causing Serious Injury (5-year-felony) each count

Using various law enforcement technologies, members of the Warren Police Special Operations unit together with the Auburn Hills Police Department were able to locate and arrest Terry at his workplace in Auburn Hills. Terry was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Warren Police Department. In speaking with investigators about this incident, Terry admitted his involvement and provided investigators with the location of his Dodge Charger. Investigators recovered the Dodge and transported it to the Warren Police Department for additional processing.

On 07/03/2024, Terry was arraigned by Judge Chupa of the 37th District Court in Warren wherein a not guilty plea was entered. Bond was set at \$1 million cash/surety only with a steel cuff tether require if released. Terry's preliminary exam is set for 07/23/2024.
