Warren Police on scene of Shots Fired at McDonald's – No suspects or victims on scene

The Warren Police Department would like to provide an initial update to a shooting which occurred this evening (10/04/2024) at the McDonald's at 9 Mile and Van Dyke (23,000 Van Dyke). There are no known victims at this time with all persons involved having fled the scene prior to police arrival. As of this point, there is no apparent danger to the public.

A preliminary investigation into this incident has shown that, on 10/04/2024 at approximately 5:00 pm, Warren Police Units were dispatched to the McDonald's at 9 Mile and Van Dyke regarding a shooting. Dispatch received several calls about multiple shots being fired in the parking lot. Officers arrived on scene and found multiple shell casings consistent with a shooting. From what investigators have gathered so far, it appears that occupants of a white Chrysler 300 and a silver/gray sedan fired several shots at each in the parking lot of the McDonald's. After exchanging gunfire, both vehicles fled the scene in separate directions. As of this point, investigators have no reported victims and no known suspects. Thankfully, as of this point in the investigation, it does not appear that any innocent bystanders were stuck by the gunfire. Evidence Technicians arrived to process the scene which included the collection of more than 10 shell casings. Investigators do not believe there is an active threat to the public at this time. Investigators will be reviewing CCTV video footage as well as speaking with any witnesses to gather more information into this incident.
